DECOMPOSED BODY FOUND

Another Mystery At Kuala Lumpur

(From Our Own Reporter)

Kuala Lumpur, Sept 7.

NOTHER mystery, believed to be a murder, is engaging the attention at the Kuala Lumpur detective branch. On Monday last a Chinese woman living in the village of Gonggang, on the outskirts of Kuala Lumpur, reported to the police that her husband had been missing since Saturday night.

Investigations by the police to trace the man's whereabouts were unsuccessful until yesterday, when acting on in-formation gleaned, detectives visited a spot near the rifle range and recovered the body of a male Chinese, buried in a swamp, who was identified as the husband of the woman who made the re-

port to the police on Monday.

Although the body was in a decomposed condition, it is understood that murder is suspected as the cause of death.
