Mrs. Scott, wife of Captain D. Scott of the s.s. Hebe, returned from home yester. day by the S S. Glenfarg.


Mr. H. G. Biggwither, of the Siamese Customs Department, is leaving for home, after six years' service. He will not be returning to Siam.
