## RUBBER ITEMS.

The Djapoera (Indragiri) Rubber Co.'s output for July amounts to 10,670 lbs., making a total for the eleven months of the current financial year of 62,525 lbs.

Figures of the output of Tebrau Rubber Estates, for the year ended June 30, 1913, are as follow:—Output for 12 months, 223,209 lbs., surplus for year, i.e., difference between the estimated dry weight and the actual dry weight 9,587 lbs. Total output for year 232,796 lbs.

Mr. W. R. MacAndrew, manager of the Bukit Jalil Estate, Pataling, was summoned by an estate coolie named Mariappa, at Kuala Lumpur police court on Tuesday, before Mr. L. Complainant came drunk, and was very impertinent, asking defendant who he was, and what right he had to send for complainant like that. The magistrate enforced a fine of \$50.
