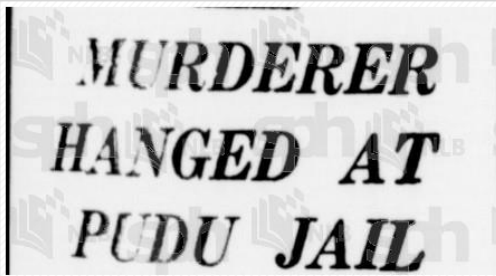

KUALA LUMPUR, March 21.—A tapper, Raja Gopal, 20, who was convicted in the High Court last April of the murder of another tapper, K. Kandiah, was hanged this morning in Pudu Jail.

Raja Gopal had been found guilty of murdering Kandiah at the sixth mile, Selama road, near Taiping, on May 15, 1959.

When the case was heard before Mr. Justice Azmi, the Deputy Public Prosecutor, Inche Abdul Haris bin Omar, said that Raja Gopal was "mercilessly
