### Kuala Lumpur flooded after downpour

KUALA LUMPUR, Wed. —Several low-lying areas in the city were flooded after an hour of heavy downpour which began at about 3 p.m. today.

The worst affected area was Kampung Reddy where the water rose to a height of nearly three feet.

The other affected areas were the Jalan Ipoh wholesale market, Maxwell Road and the fire station there and several areas in the hospital. No one left their homes as the water slowly subsided after the rain.


