Man dies after stick attack by gang

KUALA LUMPUR, Wed. — Lorry attendant Tan Tian Fo, 24, who was assaulted by a group of youths armed with Kandar sticks at Jalan Maxwell wholesale market early today, died in hospital here five hours later.

Tan was unloading a cargo of fish soon after arriving here from Teluk Anson when he was at-

tacked by about 10 to 15 youths.

He collapsed in a pool of blood. The lorry driver managed to escape.

The lorry driver drove back to Teluk Anson where he informed Tan's family of the attack.

Police believe the motive of the killing was business rivalry.
